



WooCommerce Product 360° Image

PLUGIN DOCUMENTATION

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1- System Requirements

For WooCommerce Product 360 Image Plugin you should install the last version of [wordpress](#) and [WooCommerce](#).

2- Features

- Easy configuration.
- Assign product image 360 to custom product.
- Put product image 360 image **shortcode** easily on anywhere.
- Show / Hide Full screen button.
- Show / Hide Navigation button(next, previous, play and pause buttons).
- Set frame rate and play speed for image 360.
- Working with any theme.

3- Installation

For install this plugin you must have a working version of Wordpress already installed. Upon downloading the **iThemeland WooCommerce Product 360 Image** plugin archive, extract the archive and inside extract folder you will find full contents of your purchase.

iThemeland-WooCommerce-Product-360-Image.zip archive contains the installable plugin files.

Please Note: You can install the plugin in two ways: inside Wordpress, or via FTP. If you have trouble installing the theme inside Wordpress, please proceed with installing it via FTP and you will be able to get around the issue.

Installing from Wordpress:

Follow the steps below to install inside Wordpress

- Navigate to **Plugins -> Installed Plugins**
- Click **Add New** and then **Upload Plugin**
- Navigate to **iThemeland-WooCommerce-Product-360-Image.zip** on your computer and click **Install Now**
- To activate the newly installed plugin navigate to **Plugins -> Installed Plugins** select the **iThemeland WooCommerce Product 360 Image** and press **Activate**

Installing via FTP Server:

Follow the steps below to install via FTP

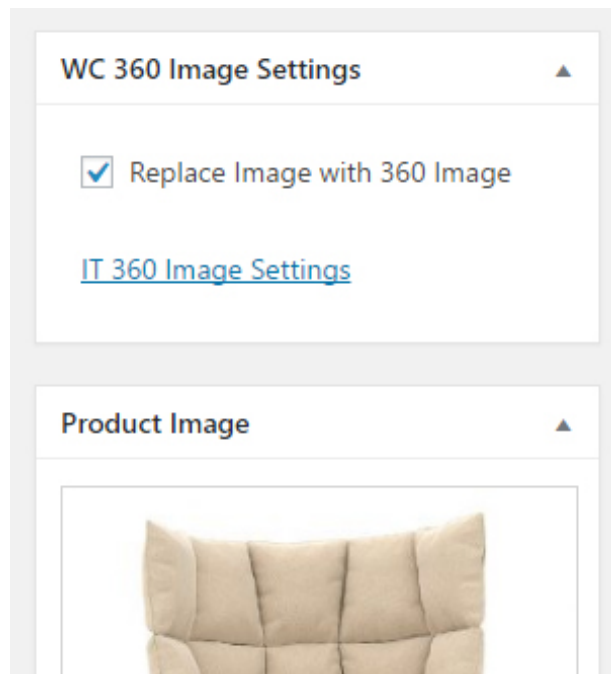
- Unzip **iThemeland-WooCommerce-Product-360-Image.zip** to a desired location on your HDD. These extracted files will be uploaded later via FTP
- Connect to your server via FTP
- Navigate to **/wp-content/plugins/** on server
- Navigate to location of unzipped **iThemeland-WooCommerce-Product-360-Image.zip**
- Upload local folder **/ iThemeland-WooCommerce-Product-360-Image /** to remote **/wp-content/plugins/**
- To activate the newly installed plugin navigate to **Plugins -> Installed Plugins** select the **iThemeland WooCommerce Product 360 Image** and press **Activate**

4- How To Use

With this plugin you can show product image 360° view instead product featured image. This image is full controllable that mean you can rotate it frame by frame, rotate continuously with play button and full screen image with a button.

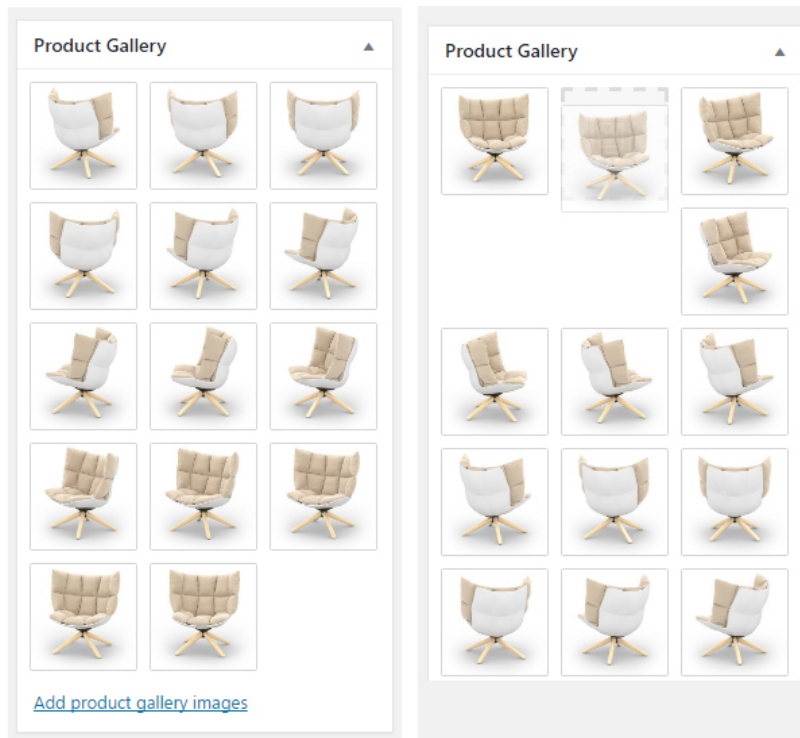
4.1- Usage

After activating the plugin, you'll find a new meta box on the the edit screen for single products, directly above the gallery meta box on the right side.




For using image 360 instead feature image check **replace image with 360 image** and then on **Product Gallery** meta box select your product 360 images. (Note: for best view of product image, use same naming with alphabetic on number for example **product-2.jpg**, **product-2.jpg**).

Also you can easy to manually change image order or remove them.



And then click on view product and all things is done. Your image rotator will be displayed!



4.2- Plugin settings

This plugin have a setting page. For access it go to **Woocommerce -> Setting -> Product -> 360 image** and click it.

Single label settings

The following settings are available in settings area.

- **Full Screen** : Show / Hide expand(full screen) button.
- **Label**: Show / Hide navigation buttons(next, previous, play and pause buttons)
- **Frame Rate** : Play Frame rate(few number more speed).
- **Play Speed** : Speed of image rotator after click on play button.

4.3- Plugin Shortcode

There is also an extra shortcode you can use – **[it360]**, to display the image rotator wherever you'd like. You can only have one rotator per page.

Here's what it looks like with all its attributes:



```
[it360 id="" width="" height=""]
```

Using of this shortcode On a single product page, don't need to include the ID. So just **[it360]** would work, optionally with some dimensions.

However, if you pass in the Product ID, it will display the rotator for that product.

Note: dimensions are optional but can be helpful.

4.4- How to Take 360° Photos

The following guides may help you in taking your photos. Basically, you want to take between 12-36 photos all from even angles. It's useful to put your product on a platform / disc that can easily be rotated so you don't have to move the product or the camera for each photo.

5. Action and Filter Reference

5.1- Image Size Name

By default, it uses the image size **shop_single**'s size, that you can set under **WooCommerce -> Settings -> Products** in the **Product Image Size** section. You can filter the image size itself that you've added by using the following filter:

```
add_filter( 'it360_image_size', 'it_360_image_name' );

function it_360_image_name() {

    return 'shop_thumbnail';

}
```

5.2- Image Size Output

The image size that is actually output is by default the full size. This is so the fullscreen output looks best. However, you may not use the fullscreen option! If so, you may want to change this to something else. You can use a filter like this to do that:

```
add_filter( 'it360_output_image_size', 'it_360_image_size_output' );

function it_360_image_size_output() {

    return 'shop_single';

}
```

5.3- Image Content Output

There is also a filter for the output of the content itself. This is a basic example of filtering it (but won't actually do anything new):

```
add_filter( 'it360_image_output', 'it_360_image_output' );

function it_360_image_output( $content ) {

    return $content;

}
```

5.4- Image Shortcode Content Output

You may also want to filter the content of the [it360] shortcode itself. Again, a basic example here:

```
add_filter( 'it360_shortcode_image_output', 'it_360_shortcode_image_output' );

function it_360_shortcode_image_output( $content ) {

    return $content;

}
```

6- FAQ

6.1- My 'Sale' icon isn't displaying over the image anymore! How do I get it back?

Add the following to your custom.css file or with a plugin like Simple Custom CSS.

```
span.onsale { z-index: 999 !important; }
```

6.2- What about the featured image?

This should just be a clear image of the product you want to display on archive pages and in Google search results, etc. The 360 Image Rotator only displays on the product's single page.

6.3- It's not displaying for me at all.. what did I do wrong?

Try switching to the default Twenty fifty theme (or another WordPress core theme). Is it working then?

If so, I'm afraid it's a theme-related issue where the theme developer has been a bit naughty and isn't display the product image correctly. If it still isn't showing, it may be a plugin conflict. Again, try deactivating all other plugins and see if it works. If so, activate each one-by-one until you find the culprit. Feel free to open up a support ticket and we'll do our best to fix it up for you though, or at least provide you with the correct information to pass onto the other theme/plugin developer.
